

Installation Instructions:

Top (plan) view of door opening (out-swing type)



USED AS A TRADITIONAL SADDLE:

- Measure width of door opening from jamb to jamb and stop to stop and mark ends of threshold for trimming.
- 2. Trim ends of threshold to fit around door jambs and
- 3. Drill pilot holes in floor through pre-drilled holes in threshold.
- 4. Caulk ends of threshold, and under full length of legs (important for effective sealing and moisture control).
- Secure threshold to floor with supplied screws. (When fastening to concrete, use anchors; anchors not included.)

USED AS AN EXPANSION JOINT COVER:

- Place threshold in desired position.
- 2. Drill pilot holes through pre-drilled holes in threshold on stationary side of application.
- 3. Caulk ends of threshold and under full length of legs on stationary side of applications.
- 4. Secure threshold to floor with supplied screws. (When fastening to concrete, use anchors; anchors not included.)

NOTE: In this application one side will be free-floating to allow for the expansion and contraction of the expansion joint.

NOTE:

This threshold is designed with a flexible joint to allow its use in several different applications. Installation may differ from those outlined above and should be installed as is appropriate for your application.
